Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.163 dated 01.07.2015, under Sections 22, 61, 85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar, petitioner was arrested on 29.07.2016 and is in Jail since then after the presentation of the F.S.L. report by the Investigating Officer with the trial Court.

Upon perusal of the FSL report and looking to the nature of offence, namely that the contraband is marginally 3 grams higher from commercial quantity, I think the petitioner should be granted bail particularly because there is no offence reported against her of the similar nature. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would not indulge into such offence.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed.

Petitioner be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence.
