This is third application for bail. Petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 30.04.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the quantity of Diphenoxylate hydrochloride recovered from the petitioner is 53.2 gms which is marginally higher than the commercial quantity prescribed under law.

Learned State counsel informs that evidence of the prosecution is complete and the case is fixed for defence evidence.

In view of the status of the trial, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court that in case the trial is not concluded within a period of two months after the next date of hearing, the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.
