Heard learned counsel for the rival parties and perused the interim order dated 04.08.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In FIR No.28 dated 17.02.2016, under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar City, petitioner was granted ad-interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 04.08.2016 by this Court.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has not paid back the amount of ₹47,500/- which was given through cheque issued by the petitioner himself.

Upon perusal of the FIR, I find that the cheque related to the year 2011 which bounced in 2011 and the FIR has been registered by the complainant after the number of years. In that view of the matter, I think, the petitioner is entitled to grant of anticipatory bail.

Hence, interim order dated 04.08.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
