The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.69, dated 7.3.2015, registered under Sections 148, 149, 452, 323, 324, 325, 326, 307, 302, 506 of the IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Sadar Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was

empty handed; is not able to walk as he is handicap to the extent of 75%

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as per the disability certificate and, therefore, chances of false implication can be there. He has been in custody since 26.5.2015.

Learned Addl. AG Haryana, on instructions from ASI Om Parkash, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
