Petitioner in the capacity as Reader to SDM has demanded and received a sum of Rs. 35,000/- as illegal gratification on a trap having been laid. Though the allegation against the petitioner are serious but in view of the fact that the challan has already been presented and the trial is likely to take a long time, petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that he will not indulge in similar activity of which he is accused of, during the pendency of the trial.
