Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, namely, Sinder Kaur and Amandeep Kaur in case FIR No.33 dated 24.3.2015 under Section 302 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Barnala, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have already appeared before the trial Court and they are ready to face the trial.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid contention raised by learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition. However, the petitioners are directed to furnish bail

bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court within a period of one week from today.
