This is a petition which has been filed under Section 439

Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.42 dated

08.01.2016, registered under Sections 394, 379-B IPC & Section 25 of

the Arms Act, at Police Station City Karnal, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the victim and his son both have turned hostile and that the petitioner has been in custody for the last almost more than 9 months.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Jai Pal has accepted these factual assertions.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
