This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 for holding fair and impartial inquiry into the representation (Annexure P-5) by some senior police official.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a representation (Annexure P-5) was moved to respondent No.2 on April 07, 2016 but till date no action has been taken on the said representation. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated April 07, 2016 (Annexure P-1) within a stipulated period.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Sidakmeet Singh Sandhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be

supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated April 07, 2016 (Annexure P-5) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
