Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuing direction to respondents No.2 to 4 for arresting respondents No.5 to 13 and to hand over the case registered at Police Station Kanina, District Mahendergarh vide FIR No.266 dated 25.7.2015, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 166 and 302 IPC to some other investigating agency or some senior officer not below the rank of Superintendent of Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though the FIR No.266 dated 25.7.2015, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 166 and 302 IPC, was registered at Police Station Kanina, District Mahendergarh, but the police has not shown any progress in the case. He states that the petitioner has already submitted a representation (Annexure P-3) in this regard, but no

action thereof has been taken.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, Deputy A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to take note of the representation dated 7.8.2015 (Annexure P-3) and act in accordance with law.
