Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.13 dated 08.02.2016, registered at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga, under Sections 324, 452, 323, 336, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

In pursuance of the order dated 04.08.2016 passed by this

Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is now not required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 04.08.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
