The petitioners are the owners of the trucks, which were intercepted while carrying wheat, meant for BPL ration card holders, for unauthorized sale in open market. The petitioners were not arrested from the spot. They have joined the investigation. Their culpability will certainly be a debatable issue.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and it is

ordered that in case of arrest of the petitioners, they shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that they will join the investigation as and when required by the investigating officer and that they will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner.
