By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C., Sukhdev Singh @ Sukha has sought bail in case FIR No.34, dated June 07, 2016, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 148, 149, 326 IPC, registered at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran, during the pendency of the trial.

Allegations against the petitioner are that he while armed with Dattar dealt its blow on the left thigh of Gurprit Singh @ Gopi-complainant near railway crossing in the area of Village Machhike on June 06, 2016 at about 7:00 PM and the said injury falls within the ambit of Section 324 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, whereas, his co-accused namely Resham Singh,

Surat Singh, Yagraj Singh @ Jagga and Daler Singh caused some other injuries to the complainant. The injuries which have been declared greivous in nature have been attributed to the co-accused of the petitioner. The petitioner was arrested by the police on June 10, 2016. Since then, he is suffering incarceration. Presentation of challan and its disposal is likely to take long time. Thus, this Court is of the considered view that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

Accordingly, in view of the facts narrated above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition stands allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate.
