The petitioners through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seek a direction to respondent No.3, Sulakhan Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur, not to humiliate and harass the petitioners by calling them to his office at the instance of private respondent No.5, Manjit Singh.

On asking of the Court, learned State counsel on the instructions of ASI Balwinder Singh informs that no case has been

registered against the petitioners till date, but a complaint of Manjit Singh has been received which is being inquired into.

In view of the said circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioners are required to be presented in the Police Station, they will be issued a notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. and in case an FIR is registered against them at the instance of Manjit Singh, they will be issued a prior notice of five days in order to enable them to avail the legal remedy available to them in accordance with law.
