Petitioners have preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the FIR (Annexure P-1) bearing FIR No.175, dated 08.11.2004, under Sections 379, 447, 506, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala on the basis of compromise dated 10.11.2004.

Reply on behalf of respondent No.2 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that respondent No.2 is not aware of any compromise and, therefore, question of quashing the FIR on the basis of compromise does not arise.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 also states that respondent No.2 is not ready to quash the FIR on the basis of compromise.
