Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, in a case arising out of F.I.R No. 222 of 07.06.2016 under Section 406/498-A/323 IPC, registered at P.S. Civil Lines Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the parties submits that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and they have decided to abide by the agreement dated 04.10.2016.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that the matter stands compromise vide report of Mediation dated 04.10.2016, order dated 09.08.2011 passed by this Court is made absolute shall abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to file fresh bail bonds after presentation of the challan.
