FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 24.02.2016 sent by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Sukhmander Singh son of Jit Singh Gagandeep Singh, Amandeep Singh son of Sukhmander Singh, Amandeep Singh @ Amna, Amandeep Singh son of Harbans Singh, Manjit Singh, Sukhmander Singh son of Jora Singh and Harjinder Singh @ Rajinder Singh as well as of complainants Jasvir Singh, Lakhveer Singh, Tahal Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view the same and the fact that the injuries to the injured Tahal Singh and Lakhveer Singh are reported to be simple in nature and that no offence under Section 307 IPC is made

out as it is not a fire injury and that it is a non-injury case and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.73 dated 16.04.2014 under Sections 307,427,188,148,149 IPC and Sections 25,27,54,59 of Arms Act Police Station, City South, Moga, District Moga and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
