The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.115, dated 22.2.2016, registered under Sections 147, 149, 188, 395, 436, 452 of the IPC, at Police Station City Hansi, District Hisar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that apart from the merits of the case, the petitioner is a government servant who was on duty at that time and the complainant gave an affidavit that the

petitioner's name was inadvertently mentioned.

Learned DAG Haryana, on instructions from SI Pawan Kumar, has accepted these factual assertions but states that the petitioner was a part of the mob.

Be that as it may, without commenting upon the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
