The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR
No.190, dated 5.6.2016, registered under Sections 61/1/14 of Excise Act,
at Police Station City Sangrur.

On the last date, the following contention was noticed :-

“ Learned counsel has argued that the petitioner
was not arrested from the spot in a case where there
was recovery of 96 bottles of illicit liquor.”

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from ASI

Rajwinder Singh, has accepted this factual assertion.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
