By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought regular bail in FIR No.107, dated 04.11.2015, registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, at Police Station City-I Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioners are agents of the crown company and they used to deposit the amount in the accounts of the company. No amount has been usurped by the petitioners. They are in custody since 24.09.2015.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel states that the petitioners in connivance with main accused have usurped huge amount, therefore, the present bail application deserves dismissal.

Heard.

The petitioners in connivance with main accused have usurped huge amount from the general public. The petitioners were allowed interim bail on the basis of undertaking made by the Managing Director of the company that he would discharge his liability including the liability made out in the present FIR. Since the bail petition of main accused has been dismissed, therefore, the order dated 12.08.2016, is vacated and the present petition is dismissed.
