Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail, inter alia, on the ground that he has been in custody for the last more than three years.

On the instructions of HC Gurnam Singh, it has been informed by the State counsel that after arrest of co-accused of the petitioner only three witnesses have been examined.

Taking into consideration, the period of detention already suffered by the petitioner, I am of the opinion that directions can be given in the present case for expeditious disposal of the trial.

It is ordered that the prosecution will examine all the witnesses within a period of six months and in case the trial is not concluded within a period of six months, the petitioner will be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
