Petitioners claim that there is a threat to their life and liberty on account of the fact that a civil suit has been filed by Beant Singh in which the petitioners are party but the petitioners are not permitted to appear as a witness and they have got threat to their life and liberty.

A complaint seems to have been filed to SHO, Police Station, Kathgarh, annexure P-1 by the petitioners on August 27, 2015 wherein it is mentioned that Paramjit Singh had inflicted injuries on the person of Beant Singh and gave beatings to his Chowkidar and also threatened the petitioners.

The allegations appear to be of August, 2015. Petitioners again filed a complaint to SP, Nawanshehar, annexure P-2 on May 25, 2016

wherein they complained that an attempt was being made to dispossess them forcibly by the private respondents.

The allegations in the complaint submitted to SHO and SP prima facie do not seem to constitute any cognizable offence as such I do not deem it appropriate to issue any direction on the basis of the material forming part of the report. However, in case there is any reasonable apprehension of breach of peace or threat to the life or limb of the petitioners it will be open to the petitioners to file an application before the competent police officer in writing expecting that on examining the authenticity of said application, necessary steps would be taken to ensure the prevention of breach of peace or threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners.
