The petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Jagtar Singh and Naginder Singh alleging that the petitioner in connivance with his brother-in-law Nachhatar Singh and others had committed fraud with the complainants by duping them by a sum of Rs.4,00,000/-, taking Rs.2,00,000/- from each of them on the false promise that their sons would be sent to Singapore permanently.

A perusal of the police file indicates that the petitioner has admitted in the police custody that he has received Rs.30,000/- from the complainant and handed over the same to mother of Nachhatar Singh co-accused.

Challan has been presented. The petitioner is in custody w.e.f. 19.11.2015. Trial is likely to take a long time. In view of the said circumstances, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
