This order will dispose of two criminal petitions bearing CRM-M Nos.2687 and 13312 of 2016 as both of them have arisen out of the same FIR. The facts of the case are taken from CRM-M No.2687 of 2016.

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the FIR No.319 dated 03.10.2015 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala.

Allegations against the petitioners are that they have obtained by fraud huge amount from the complainant by taking advantage of fake sale deeds and the fact that one of them was his brother-in-law.

On 24.08.2016, following order was passed:

"Learned counsel for the petitioners seek an adjournment to ascertain from the petitioners whether they are ready to return the money they have duped from the complainant.

Adjourned to 31.08.2016.

A photocopy of this order be placed on the files of the connected cases."

However, today learned counsel prays that the petition be decided on merits.

Keeping in view the nature of the allegations and the amount allegedly misappropriated by the petitioners and the scope of allegations, I do not deem it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Petition stands dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
