Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.17 dated 29.01.2014 registered under Sections 420, 120-B and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Model Town, Ludhiana City, District Ludhiana, the petitioners are being prosecuted.

Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as counsel for the complainant submits that Compromise (Annexure-P-3) has been arrived at between the parties. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the entire amount has been paid back to the complainant and, therefore, cause of action does not survive. He further states that not only the payment has been made to the complainant, but even cost in the sum of ₹20,000/- has also been paid to the State Government pursuant to the order dated July 22, 2016.

This Court vide order dated August 08, 2016 had directed the

trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to record the statements of the parties in view of the compromise and verify that whether the same is genuine or not.

Accordingly, report has been received from the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana, showing that the statements of the parties have been recorded in view of the compromise and the same is genuine and without any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In that view of the matter, FIR No.17 dated 29.01.2014 registered under Sections 420, 120-B and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Model Town, Ludhiana City, District Ludhiana, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
