The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.277, dated 14.12.2013, registered under Section 15/16/27A/61/85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the earlier petition for bail filed by the petitioner was dismissed on 17.12.2015 but a direction was given to the prosecution to conclude its entire evidence expeditiously. However, despite a lapse of almost nine months, the

evidence has not been concluded.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from ASI Leelu Ram, states that the prosecution would now conclude its entire evidence on or before 5.12.2016 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

Keeping in view the statement of counsel for the respondent, I dismiss this petition at this stage but direct the trial Court to release the petitioner on bail in case the prosecution fails to conclude the evidence on or before 5.12.2016 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.
