The petitioner has been in custody, w.e.f. 26.04.2016, on the allegation that she has duped the complainant with a false promise of allocating him work for installation of mobile tower on the receipt of Rs. 10,00,000/-.

The application for bail has been refused by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, on the ground that the sum of Rs. 10,00,000/- is yet to be recovered.

Challan has already been presented on 20.06.2016. The trial is not likely to be concluded in near future. Detention of the petitioner during entire period of trial with a hope that the amount will be recovered will cause unnecessary prejudice to the

petitioner.

Since petitioner is a lady and challan has already been presented, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to a condition that petitioner will not indulge in any activity of cheating during pendency of the trial. In case of such activity, it will be open to the prosecution agency to seek the cancellation of bail.
