The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.60,
dated 4.4.2016, registered under Sections 394, 342, 34 of the IPC, at
Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has
been in custody since 15.4.2016 and the only material against him is the
statement of co-accused that he opened the gate for them.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab has accepted these factual

assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
