This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of interim bail of 30 days to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.07 dated 20.01.2015 registered under Sections 17/18/27A/29/61/85 of NDPS Act, at Police Station-Odhan, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the mother of the petitioner is suffering from various ailments and apart from his old father there

is no other male member in the family.

Learned DAG, Haryana on instructions from SI Krishan Kumar has accepted these factual assertions. He however stated that there is recovery of 9 k.g. Opium.

I find this to be a fair request. In the circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case , I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on interim bail. Trial court is directed to obtain adequate security to deter the petitioner from absconding.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.
