Report dated 01.06.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Pritpal Singh @ Harpreet Singh and Mandeep Singh as well as of complainant Manjit Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a non-injury case and the offences are not heinous in nature and that the parties have effected a

compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.37 dated 02.05.2011 under Sections 452,336,506,148,149 IPC and Sections 25,27,54,59 of the Arms Act, Police Station, Dehlon, District Ludhiana and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
