Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondents Nos. 1 to 6 to protect the life and liberty and property belonging to the petitioner on account of false implication involvement of petitioner's son.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved representations (Annexures P-3) and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate action on his representation. I find this to be a fair request.

The respondent No.2-the Director General of Police, Punjab is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
