This judgment will dispose of CRM-M 26174 of 2014 and CRM-M 42603 of 2015, arising out of same FIR. However, for facility of reference facts are being taken from CRM-M 26174 of 2014.

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.c. for quashing of FIR No.165 dated 4.11.2006 under Sections 326, 323, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Majitha, District

Majitha (Amritsar) along with the consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise (Annexure P2).

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar received. Statements of the complainant/ injured Vijay Kumar as well as accused were recorded. It is reported that the parties have compromised the matter and the same is without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the matter, FIR No.165 dated 4.11.2006 under Sections 326, 323, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Majitha, District Majitha (Amritsar) along with the consequential proceedings stands quashed.

Both the petitions stand allowed.
