The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.264 dated 30.06.2016, registered under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Civil Lines, Amritsar.

Heard.

On 08.08.2016, the following order was passed:-

“This is petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.264 dated 30.06.2016 under Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Police Commissionerate (Amritsar).

Notice of motion for 20.10.2016.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation

by a police officer as and when required;

2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;

3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 08.08.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
