By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C., Pawan Kumar @ Sunny has sought bail in case FIR No. 125, dated February 25, 2016, under Sections 148, 149, 188, 295, 323, 452, 435, 436 of IPC, registered at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar, during the pendency of the trial.

No doubt, instant case is the outcome of 'Jat' agitation which is alleged to have taken place in the month of February 2016 in the State of Haryana and some public property was set ablaze which caused loss to the State, but keeping in view the fact that petitioner is suffering incarceration, since, the date of his arrest i.e. March 09, 2016 as well as that after the completion of the investigation, report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. has

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already been presented.

As pointed out by learned State counsel, charge has already been framed by learned Sessions Judge, Jhajjar.

The disposal of trial is likely to take considerable time and this Court is of the considered view that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the matter, instant petition stands allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
