This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No. 297 dated 23.12.2015, under Sections 376/506 IPC, registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar.

After going through the statements made by Dr. Shama Parveen Medical Officer, PHC Bilaspur (Annexure P-6) and Meham Singh, husband of the prosecutrix (Annexure P-7), there is no doubt that the petitioner and the prosecutrix were having relationship with each other and he was not a

stranger to her. The husband of the prosecutrix has stated that he was ready

to give divorce to his wife. Similar statement has been given by the prosecutrix on 16.05.2016 that in case, the accused is ready to marry her, she would give divorce to her husband.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed that out of 14 prosecution witnesses, 4 have been examined.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may still take some time for its conclusion, this court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar.
