Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Amritpal Singh in case FIR No.66 dated 27.05.2003 for offence punishable under Section 13-A of the Punjab Village Common Land Regulation Act, 1961 registered with Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar.

Petitioner was on bail and it is apparent that he left the country without seeking the permission of the Court. Due to his absence on 10.03.2006 before the trial Court, he was declared as proclaimed offender on 04.04.2007. He has now come back and wants to face trial.

Counsel for the petitioner heard.

No case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out at the instance of a person who is staying away from the process of the Court for almost 10

years. However, the liberty granted by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, vide order dated 07.01.2016 is extended till 30.01.2016.
