This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.119 dated 16.08.2014 registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC at P.S. Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran alongwith all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel has argued that actually the other party were the aggressor and in fact cross case has been registered against them. In these circumstances, it is clear that the fight has been admitted and the only issue is which party is the aggressor. This issue can be decided only after leading evidence and without the same it will not be

possible to give any finding.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
