After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.

However, the personal presence of the petitioner is exempted before the trial Court, subject to the following conditions:- (i) petitioner shall be represented through counsel; (ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings; (iii) shall not dispute her/their identity as an accused; (iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in her/their absence but in the presence of his/their counsel; (v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court; and (vi) any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.
