Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of appropriate direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect and safeguard the life of the petitioners. Further prayer has been made that the police should not harass the petitioners at the instance of respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that respondent No.4 solemnized marriage with Gaurav Sharma son of petitioners No.1 and 2. They have some matrimonial dispute and accordingly proceedings under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act have been initiated by them. Despite the fact that the dispute is in between respondent No.4 and her husband, petitioners are being made to suffer and humiliated. He further states that the petitioners have already approached respondent No.2-The

Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar by moving representation dated 10.7.2016 (Annexure P-5) and have brought to his notice the harassment being met by them but no remedial action thereof has been taken.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, Deputy A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the contents of representation dated 10.7.2016 (Annexure P-5) and act in accordance with law.
