Heard learned counsel for the rival parties and perused the interim order dated 08.08.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

In FIR No.90 dated 13.08.2015, under Sections 382, 341, 325, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Bahaw Wala, Tehsil Abohar, District Fazilka, petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail.

This Court had issued interim order dated 08.08.2016 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Partap Singh, states that pursuant to the said order, the petitioners have joined investigation and custody is not required.

Looking to the nature of offence alleged against the

petitioners, I am inclined to confirm the interim order dated 08.08.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

In that view of the matter, interim order dated 08.08.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
