This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 70 dated 26.4.2016 under Section 18C, 18-A of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 read with Sections 336/420 IPC and Section 3, 4 and 5 of Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971 and Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Pillu Khera.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that he would not press the petition on merits. He has made a limited prayer that since the FSL report has not been received, therefore, the petitioner be released on interim bail till the receipt thereof.

Mr. Amrik Narwal, DAG., Haryana submits that petitioner has committed a serious offence under the NDPS Act. He has accepted the fact that FSL report has not yet been received and the

petitioner is in custody since 9.5.2016.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the above facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial court/Duty Magistrate. The prayer for regular bail will be considered by the trial court on receipt of report from the FSL.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.
