INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.73 dated 22.02.2015, registered at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak, under Sections 302, 34 and 120-B IPC (added later on) and Section 25 of the Arms Act.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record. Police record is also available.

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From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, was registered on the statement of Bhuro, who stated that on 22.02.2015, at about 5.00 p.m., she was going towards her *Gher*. When she entered in the door of *Gher*, she heard a noise and she hurriedly entered into the *gher* in order to know as to what kind of sound was that. On entering into the *gher*, she found that the present petitioner and co-accused were running away by climbing the staircase and were saying that they have killed him today. The complainant saw that her husband, Mahender was lying on the cot and blood was oozing from his mouth and forehead.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the facts that the present petitioner has been named in the FIR and there is every possibility that if the petitioner is released on bail, he may tamper with the evidence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
