Petitioner-Deepak Verma has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.118 dated 25.09.2015, registered at Police Station Division No.4, Jalandhar, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the statement of Sh. Pawan Sharma, Deputy Manager, Bajaj Finance, who stated that accused-Deepak Verma was working as a Sales Executive for the last about eight months. As per allegations, the accused has played a fraud upon the complainant-finance company to the

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tune of ₹30 lacs and the accused in connivance with other persons forged documents by preparing delivery orders etc. and misappropriated the articles.

In the present case, since the petitioner is the main accused and recovery is still to be effected from him, therefore, his custodial interrogation is required.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
