INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in DDR No.42 dated 20.01.2014, registered under Sections 420, 406, 211 and 182 IPC, at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar City, in FIR No.15 dated 20.01.2014, registered under Section 382 IPC, at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar City.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has given up respondent Nos.2 to 5 being unnecessary.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent No.1-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as

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learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner absented from the court proceedings on 28.01.2016 as he had noted down wrong date. His bail was cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued.

In view of the interim order dated 27.09.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and the fact that trial of the case will take a long time and no useful purpose would be served by sending the petitioner to custody, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 27.09.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
