The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR
No.80, dated 12.5.2016, registered under Sections 323, 324, 34, 307 of
the IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station E-
Division, Amritsar City.

Counsel for the petitioners states that a similarly situated co-

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accused, namely, Shivani alias Shibu has been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 26.7.2016 passed in CRM-M No.23202 of 2016.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab as well as counsel for the complainant have accepted this factual assertion.

In these circumstances, I do not see any ground to take a different view. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of their arrest, the petitioners shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
