In FIR No.68 dated 27.05.2013 registered under Sections 406 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Chattiwind District Amritsar. the petitioner is being prosecuted.

Now, there is a motion for quashment of FIR by way of compounding/compromise. Mr. Vinay Begra, Advocate for the complainant states that now the compromise has taken place between the parties. This Court had made an order dated March 10, 2016 directing the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate and get their statements recorded. The statements have been recorded by the Illaqa Magistrate and this Court had received the same. It is stated therein that the compromise arrived at between the parties and the same is genuine and without any pressure or undue influence.

In that view of the matter, FIR No.68 dated 27.05.2013 registered under Sections 406 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Chattiwind District Amritsar is quashed by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
