The present petition has been preferred under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by Sumanjeet Kaur, feeling apprehension of her arrest, in case bearing FIR No.57 dated 21.04.2016, under Sections 324, 323, 506, 34 of IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar (Rural).

At the time of issuance of notice of motion by this Court on August 08, 2016, the following order was passed:-

“Heard.”

Notice of motion to the respondent for
19.09.2016.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the investigation. In the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on pre-arrest bail at the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer subject to the conditions, as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C”.

On instructions from HC Balkar Singh, learned State counsel submits that petitioner has already joined the investigation in compliance of the order dated August 08, 2016 and her further custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

Taking into consideration the above facts of the case, interim order dated August 08, 2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions, as envisaged under section 438(2) Cr.P.C and shall enure during the pendency of the trial.
