Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.117 dated 24.5.2016 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326 IPC registered at Police Station Salhawas, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 8.8.2016 of this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Siri Krishan, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and submits that the custody of the petitioners is no more required.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation and their custody is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 8.8.2016 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
