This petition has been filed against the order of the trial Court declining an application moved by the petitioner for permission to have his signatures compared on the cheque in dispute. The trial Court has been influenced by the fact that in his statement under Section 313 Cr.P.C. the petitioner had categorically stated that the respondent-complainant had obtained a blank signed cheque from him and, therefore, held that a subsequent application praying for comparison of signatures would not lie.

I see no reason to take a different view.

Petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the Civil Misc.  
Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
