On asking of the Court, Mr. Ankur Jain, AAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice. Copy given.

The matter is covered by the judgment of this Court in **Pradeep Kumar Vs. State of Haryana, 2008 (3) RCR (Criminal) 376.**

This petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioners will not be forcibly taken in custody by any of the respondents on the allegation that petitioner No.1 has been kidnapped or abducted by petitioner

No.2. In case of any imminent threat to the petitioners, it will be open to them to approach the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar for appropriate protection.
