Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.44 dated 27.05.2014, registered under Section 22 of the N.D.P.S. Act, at Police Station Lambra District, Jalandhar City.

Learned counsel states that the petitioner has been facing trial regularly since 2014 and missed only one date because he had wrongly noted the same and he never misused the concession of bail.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it appropriate to direct the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court. Ordered accordingly. The trial Court shall release him on bail to its satisfaction in case the assertion that the petitioner had never misused the concession of bail is correct.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
